For students ages 8-18 who are new to 4-H goat club. Each week we will have classroom time with informative goat topics and then hands-on time with the 4-H goats.



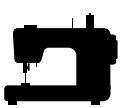
ADVANCED GOAT CLUB

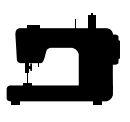

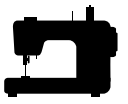

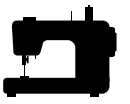
TIMBERTIME WOODWORKING CLUB
